Lesson	Text	Verse
1	1 John 4:8	“Anyone who does not love does not know God - for God is love”
2	Deuteronomy 30:20a	“Choose to love the Lord your God and to obey him and commit yourself to him, for he is your life”
3	John 15:9-11	“I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love. When you obey me, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father and remain in his love. I have told you this so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow!”
4	Psalms 100:1-5	“Shout with joy to the Lord, O earth! Worship the Lord with gladness. Come before him, singing with joy. Acknowledge that the Lord is God! He made us, and we are his. We are his people, the sheep of his pasture. Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise. Give thanks to him and bless his name. For the Lord is good. His unfailing love continues forever, and his faithfulness continues to each generation”
5	Philippians 4:11-13	“I have learned how to get along happily whether I have much or little. I know how to live on almost nothing or with everything. I have learned the secret of living in every situation, whether it is with a full stomach or empty, with plenty or little. For I can do everything with the help of Christ who gives me the strength I need”
6	James 1:2, 3	“Whenever trouble comes your way, let it be an opportunity for joy. For when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow”
7	John 14:27	“I am leaving you with a gift - peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give isn't like the peace the world gives. So don't be troubled or afraid”
8	Numbers 6:24-26	“May the Lord bless you and protect you. May the Lord smile on you and be gracious to you. May the Lord show you his favor and give you his peace”
9	Colossians 3:15, 16	“Let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful. Let the words of Christ, in all their richness, live in your hearts and make you wise. Use his words to teach and counsel each other. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts”
10	Philippians 4:6, 7	“Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. If you do this, you will experience God's peace, which is far more wonderful than the human mind can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus”

11	1 Thessalonians 5:14	“Brothers and sisters, we urge you to warn those of you who are lazy. Encourage those who are timid. Take tender care of those who are weak. Be patient with everyone”
12	Habakkuk 3:17-19	“Even though the fig trees have no blossoms, and there are no grapes on the vine; even though the olive crop fails, and the fields lie empty and barren; even though the flocks die in the fields, and the cattle barns are empty, yet I will rejoice in the Lord! I will be joyful in the God of my salvation. The Sovereign Lord is my strength! He will make me as surefooted as a deer and bring me safely over the mountains”
13	1 Timothy 1:16	“That is why God had mercy on me, so that Christ Jesus could use me as a prime example of his great patience with even the worst sinners. Then others will realize that they, too, can believe in him and receive eternal life”
14	Colossians 1:11a	“We also pray that you will be strengthened with his glorious power so that you will have all the patience and endurance you need”
15	Colossians 3:12	“Since God chose you to be the holy people whom he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience”
16	Matthew 7:12	“Do for others what you would like them to do for you. This is a summary of all that is taught in the law and the prophets”
17	Ephesians 4:32	“Be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you”
18	Matthew 5:43-45a	“You have heard that the law of Moses says, ‘love your neighbor and hate your enemy.’ But I say, love your enemies! Pray for those who persecute you! In that way, you will be acting as true children of your Father in heaven”
19	Matthew 5:14-16	“You are the light of the world - like a city on a mountain, glowing in the night for all to see. Don’t hide your light under a basket! Instead, put it on a stand and let it shine for all. In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father”
20	Psalms 34:12-14	“Do any of you want to live a life that is long and good? Then watch your tongue! Keep your lips from telling lies! Turn away from evil and do good. Work hard at living in peace with others”
21	Ephesians 5:8, 9	“Though your hearts were once full of darkness, now you are full of light from the Lord, and your behavior should show it! For this light within you produces only what is good and right and true”
22	Romans 12:21	“Don’t let evil get the best of you, but conquer evil by doing good”
23	Psalms 89:1, 2	“I will sing of the tender mercies of the Lord forever! Young and old will hear of your faithfulness. Your unfailing love will last forever. Your faithfulness is as enduring as the heavens”

24	Deuteronomy 7:9	“Understand, therefore, that the Lord your God is indeed God. He is the faithful God who keeps his covenant for a thousand generations and constantly love, those who love him and obey his commands”
25	Matthew 25:13	“Stay awake and be prepared, because you do not know the day or hour of my return”
26	Matthew 25:23	“The master said, ‘Well done, my good and faithful servant. You have been faithful in handling this small amount, so now I will give you many more responsibilities. Let’s celebrate together!’ ”
27	Philippians 4:5	“Let everyone see that you are considerate in all you do. Remember, the Lord is coming soon”
28	Proverbs 15:1	“A gentle answer turns away wrath, but harsh words stir up anger”
29	Ephesians 4:2	“Be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other’s faults because of your love”
30	Psalms 37:11	“Those who are gentle and lowly will possess the land; they will live in prosperous security”
31	1 Corinthians 6:19, 20	“Don’t you know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body”
32	Proverbs 16:32	“It is better to be patient than powerful; it is better to have self-control than to conquer a city”
33	Galatians 2:20	“I myself no longer live, but Christ lives in me. So I live my life in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me”
34	Proverbs 29:11	“A fool gives full vent to anger, but a wise person quietly holds it back”
35	Luke 6:27, 28	“But if you are willing to listen, I say, love your enemies. Do good to those who hate you. Pray for the happiness of those who curse you. Pray for those who hurt you”
36	1 John 3:18, 19	“Dear children, let us stop just saying we love each other; let us really show it by our actions. It is by our actions that we know we are living in the truth, so we will be confident when we stand before the Lord”
