<b>Lesson</b>	<b>Text</b>	<b>Verse</b>
1	Isaiah 9:6	“A child is born to us, a son is given to us. And the government will rest on his shoulders. These will be his royal titles: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace”
2	Matthew 1:21-23	“ ‘She will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.’ All of this happened to fulfill the Lord’s message through his prophet: ‘Look! The virgin will conceive a child! She will give birth to a son, and he will be called Immanuel (meaning, God is with us)’ ”
3	Hebrews 4:16	“Let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it”
4	Psalms 86:15	“But you, O Lord, are a merciful and gracious God, slow to get angry, full of unfailing love and truth”
5	2 Corinthians 8:7	“Since you excel in so many ways - you have so much faith, such gifted speakers, such knowledge, such enthusiasm, and such love for us - now I want you to excel also in this gracious ministry of giving”
6	Colossians 3:13, 14	“You must make allowance for each other’s faults and forgive the person who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. And the most important piece of clothing you must wear is love. Love is what binds us all together in perfect harmony”
7	Romans 6:23	“The wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord”
8	Colossians 1:13, 14	“He has rescued us from the one who rules in the kingdom of darkness, and he has brought us into the Kingdom of his dear Son. God has purchased our freedom with his blood and has forgiven all our sins”
9	Acts 4:12	“There is salvation in no one else! There is no other name in all of heaven for people to call on to save them”
10	Isaiah 12:3-5	“With joy you will drink deeply from the fountain of salvation! In that wonderful day you will sing: ‘Thank the Lord! Praise his name! Tell the world what he has done. Oh, how mighty he is! Sing to the Lord, for he has done wonderful things. Make known his praise around the world’ ”
11	Ephesians 3:20	“Now glory be to God! By his mighty power at work within us, he is able to accomplish infinitely more than we would ever dare to ask or hope”

12	Psalm 138:3	“When I pray, you answer me; you encourage me by giving me the strength I need”
13	Micah 6:8	“The Lord has already told you what is good, and this is what he requires: to do what is right, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God”
14	Psalm 34:7	“The angel of the Lord guards all those who fear him, and he rescues them”
15	John 14:6, 7	“Jesus told him, ‘I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me. If you had known who I am, then you would have known who my Father is. From now on you know him and have seen him!’ ”
16	Exodus 34:29	“When Moses came down the mountain carrying the stone tablets inscribed with the terms of the covenant, he wasn’t aware that his face glowed because he had spoken to the Lord face to face”
17	John 15:13	“Here is how to measure it - the greatest love is shown when people lay down their lives for their friends”
18	Matthew 28:19, 20	“Go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age”
19	Romans 8:38, 39	“I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from his love. Death can’t, and life can’t. The angels can’t, and the demons can’t. Our fears for today, our worries about tomorrow, and even the powers of hell can’t keep God’s love away. Whether we are high above the sky or in the deepest ocean, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord”
20	John 15:11,12	“I have told you this so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow! I command you to love each other in the same way that I love you”
21	Ezekiel 36:26	‘I will give you a new heart with new and right desires, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony heart of sin and give you a new, obedient heart”
22	John 3:16, 17	“God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. God did not send his Son into the world to condemn it, but to save it”
23	Psalm 71:15	“I will tell everyone about your righteousness. All day long I will proclaim your saving power, for I am overwhelmed by how much you have done for me”

24	1 Corinthians 3:8	“The one who plants and the one who waters work as a team with the same purpose. Yet they will be rewarded individually, according to their own hand work”
25	Colossians 1:10	“Then the way you live will always honor and please the Lord, and you will continually do good, kind things for others. All the while you will learn to know God better and better”
26	Psalms 103:11-13	“His unfailing love toward those who fear him is as great as the height of the heavens above the earth . . . The Lord is like a father to his children, tender and compassionate to those who fear him”
27	John 13:13, 14	“You call me ‘Teacher’ and ‘Lord,’ and you are right, because it is true. And since I, the Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash each other’s feet”
28	Isaiah 58:10, 11	“Feed the hungry and help those in trouble. Then your light will shine out from the darkness, and the darkness around you will be as bright as day. The Lord will guide you continually, watering your life when you are dry and keeping you healthy, too. You will be like a well-watered garden, like an ever-flowing spring”
29	John 13:15-17	“I have given you an example to follow. Do as I have done to you. How true it is that a servant is not greater than the master. Nor are messengers more important than the one who sends them. You know these things - now do them! That is the path of blessing”
30	Galatians 5:13	“You have been called to live in freedom - not freedom to satisfy your sinful nature, but freedom to serve one another in love”
31	Romans 3:22	“We are made right in God’s sight when we trust in Jesus Christ to take away our sins. And we all can be saved in this same way, no matter who we are or what we have done”
32	Romans 5:21	“Just as sin ruled over all people and brought them to death, now God’s wonderful kindness rules instead, giving us right standing with God and resulting in eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord”
33	Revelation 3:20	“Look! Here I stand at the door and knock. If you hear me calling and open the door, I will come in, and we will share a meal as friends”
34	Jude 1:24	“And now, all glory to God, who is able to keep you from stumbling, and who will bring you into his glorious presence innocent of sin and with great joy”
35	Isaiah 65:17, 18	“Look! I am creating new heavens and a new earth - so wonderful that no one will even think about the old ones anymore. Be glad; rejoice forever in my creation! And look! I will create Jerusalem as a place of happiness. Her people will be a source of joy”
36	Revelation 22:20	“He who is the faithful witness to all these things says, ‘Yes, I am coming soon!’ Amen!”
