This course in secondary methods focuses on the high school environment and the knowledge and skills needed to plan and deliver instruction in specific content areas. Bringing together secondary teaching elements such as 1) understanding the characteristics of adolescent learners, 2) examining the challenges of teaching diverse students, and 3) reviewing current best teaching practices, participants will create course syllabi, develop effective learning units, prepare sample lesson plans, and design formative and summative assessment tools. Adolescent learning, curriculum development, and legal issues within the secondary context will form the framework for this

four-day class.
