Please read carefully to ensure that you are able to register successfully.

- Due to the intensive nature of these courses and seminars, it is recommended that you register for only one course at a time. However, it is not mandatory. You may not sign up for courses that overlap in time.
- <u>HYBRID CLASSES</u> These are classes that take place at <u>both</u> PUC <u>and</u> online; usually the first half of a class is at PUC and the second half is online. The Date/Time column will show the detailed information about the exact schedule.
- <u>In order to access the internet at PUC</u> you will need to use your PUC email address and password. See the Education Summer School site for details.
- If you do not qualify for a tuition waiver, check the <u>website</u> for tuition costs.
- Failure to let Records and Education know you are dropping a class will affect your grade.
- Any extra fees for classes and workshops, including the \$75 technology fee <u>per</u> online class, are not covered by your conference. <u>Technology fees for online classes as well as any materials fees, etc. for classes will be automatically charged to your account upon registration.</u> Check the schedule for information about fees for workshops and classes.
- All of the textbooks for classes are available online from the <u>PUC Bookstore</u> website. However, since the number of textbooks available is based on past enrollment, it is important to enroll early in order to be sure of obtaining a textbook. More textbooks will be ordered as needed, if there is enough time before class begins.

## How to sign up for classes:

- 1) Fill out the registration form at www.puc.edu/summer-teacher.
  - a. You will need to have ready the course prefix, number, title, and number of credits for each class you wish to register for. A list of summer classes is available on the next three pages for your convenience
- 2) Submit a Tuition Waiver Form directly to PUC's Business Office. The form can be obtained from your conference office. Ask your conference office official to sign and submit the form.
