Please read carefully to ensure that you are able to register successfully.

- Due to the intensive nature of these courses and seminars, it is recommended that you register for only one course at a time. However, it is not mandatory. For onsite classes, you may not sign up for courses that overlap in time.
- HYBRID CLASSES These are classes that take place at **both** PUC **and** online or as hybrid courses which take place at PUC for part of the time and online for part of the time. The Date/Time column will show the detailed information about the exact schedule. **You will** need to use your PUC email address in order to access Canvas for the online portion.
- In order to access the internet at PUC or for an online class in order to access Canvas you will need to use your PUC email address and password. See the Education Summer School site for details.
- If you do not qualify for a tuition waiver, check the website for tuition costs.
- Failure to let Records and Education know you are dropping a class will affect your grade.
- Any extra fees for classes and workshops are not covered by your conference. <u>Any materials</u>

   Check the schedule for information about fees for workshops and classes.

More textbooks will be ordered as needed, if there is enough time before class begins.
