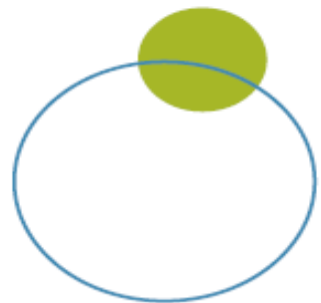

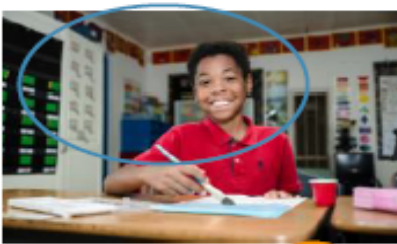
SECC SCHOOLS
